REPORT ON OUR SEPT. MEETING: Pat Roach briefed us on the Arlington Master Transportation Plan. As an oversimplification, Barcroft has three major routes: George Mason Dr., Columbia Pike, and Arlington Blvd.. Minor modifications are planned for George Mason Dr. and Columbia Pike. However, on Arlington Blvd., most stop lights would be eliminated west of George Mason Dr.. Left turns would be prohibited by the completion of a median at all intersections. After discussion, the Association voted to question the planning assumptions for Arlington Blvd. which would favor Fairfax County traffic at the expense of Arlington County. There was also a request that consideration be given to more park-like objectives along George Mason Drive.
