PROGRAM: There will be no formal program in May. However, the Nominating Committee will submit a slate of officers to be voted on. We will also consider social critical matter of new and unfinished business.

REPORT ON APRIL MEETING: The County Board no longer considers the west side of Arlington Hall a suitable site for the central police facility. Barcroft owes the Community Concerns Committee a vote of "thanks" for this reversal in policy.

Pat Roach of that Committee briefed us on the statue of Arlington Hall.

At the April 12th County Board meeting the Board accepted our proposals for the west side of the Hall.

We took the following position on the east side:

- 1. Support intensive landscaping of any property the may become available.
- 2. Support the construction and use of a closed pavillion.
- 3. Require the County to show the need for 2 ballfields.
- 4. Limit night use of the ballfields to 9:00 p.m. if installed and lighted.
- 5. Restudy the proposals for a swimming pool and golf course before eliminating these proposals.

The County Board voted to re-evaluate the proposal for a golf course.
