The Columbia Pike Revitalization Organization (CPRO) is a not-for-profit coalition of residents, property owners, and merchants, working with Arlington County to revitalize the Columbia Pike commercial corridor. Working together provides a way to keep successful businesses on The Pike and attract new businesses to serve the market better. In other words, joining CPRO gives <u>YOU</u> a role in the revitalization process.

CPRO's Accomplishments

Columbus Day Celebration - a street festival which highlights the ethnic diversity of The Pike. Disney Day - an all-Disney show at the Arlington Cinema 'n Drafthouse for children of all ages. ✓ CPRO works closely with Arlington County on projects such as:

- undergrounding utilities
- rebuilding sidewalks and gutters
- planting street trees
- O use permit regulation for fast food restaurants with drive-through windows

CPRO conducted a public market study to clarify the types of businesses residents want along The Pike. Completed in January 1990, the study has already been used to recruit:

- O Barcroft Books
- O Eye Sites
- O Faizi's Place and Restaurante Atlacatl, two sit-down restaurants
- O Columbia Pike Artist Studios
